HISTORY DETECTIVES CAMP

July 6th - 10th and August 10th - 14th (FULL)

History Detectives Wanted! A priceless jewel has vanished and time is running out to find it! Can you help to solve the mystery and claim the reward? Spend the week visiting historic sites to search for clues, solve puzzles, and learn about the past. Have fun discovering how museums really work and get behind the scenes access to some of our treasures! Activities at our education centre at Waterville include art, games and crafts.

CLIMATE CHANGE AGENTS

July 13th - 17th (FULL) and August 3rd - 7th

This camp will empower campers with the knowledge and skills to understand climate change. They will learn about global warming, carbon footprint, food miles, sustainable energy, supplychains and Bermuda's choices for a greener future. The camp will nurture critical thinking, problem solving and will engage campers in a variety of experiments and up-cycling projects.

CREATIVE LEGO CAMP

July 20th - 24th (FULL) and July 27th - 29th (FULL)



Calling all young LEGO robot designers! This exciting camp uses the LEGO WeDo2.0 system, which is a fantastic new learning tool that introduces students to robotics, engineering and programming. Our fun projects are linked to technology in Bermuda and science topics such as plants and pollinators, habitats, animal senses, ocean pollution and transport. This camp nurtures teamwork, creativity and problem-solving and includes field trips and outdoor activities.

Spend the afternoon relaxing in a creative space with your own project. Learn a new skill such as knitting, sewing, woodworking or string art and make something special to take home.
