

# Bermuda National Trust Summer Camps



The Bermuda National Trust offers fun camps for children ages 8-11 and 11-14. Each program includes interesting field trips to Bermuda's prime nature reserves and historic sites, a variety of hands-on activities and fun indoor and outdoor games.

## **Ages: 8-11 years**

### **Archaeology for Kids (July 2 - 6 and July 23 - 27)**

Campers will dig into Bermuda's history and learn the basic skills of archaeology. Discover the people of Bermuda in a new way by examining old objects called artefacts. Sort out clues from the past like a detective and rebuild our stories with the evidence. Activities include a simulated excavation and visiting the National Trust archaeology lab in St. George's.

### **Wild Things (July 9 - 13 and August 13 - 17)**

Take a walk on the wild side with nature while identifying birds, plants and insects. Campers will have a blast exploring Bermuda's most beautiful nature reserves and open spaces and enjoying the great outdoors while having picnics, making shelters and learning field craft skills.

### **Crack the Code (July 16 - 20 and August 6 - 10)**

This camp is perfect for puzzlers and scientific sleuths. Discover a world of special alphabets, codes and their uses. Learn about hidden messages that passed through Bermuda and the people that decoded them. Create your own mystery with a team to design an escape room or scavenger hunt.

## **Ages: 11-14 years**

### **3-Day Photo Camp (July 30 - Aug 1)**

This camp for 11-14 year old students will introduce them to the art of photography. Campers will explore National Trust properties, and will be instructed on how to capture their surroundings. This is a fun three-day camp which will also touch on editing of images to create special photo projects. Bring your own camera.

### **Aftercare Option: Maker's Corner 3-5 pm**

Spend the afternoon relaxing in a creative space with your own project. Learn a new skill such as knitting, sewing, woodworking or wire wrapping and build something special to take home.
