- The Michael Darling Shield for recognition of projects, programmes or initiatives by a school demonstrating care of the environment or preservation of Bermuda's heritage, both natural and man-made

Young persons demonstrating an exceptional contribution to the preservation of Bermuda's natural environment (Must be less than 26 years as of December 31, 2017).

Preservation

Individuals or groups who have made contributions to enhancing and protecting Bermuda's man-made heritage.

Environment
